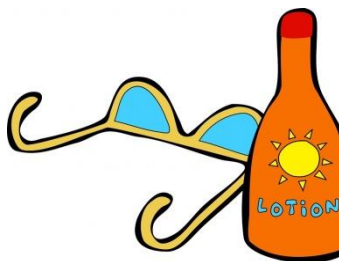
SUN SAFETY
